HOW TO GET THERE

By Road

Gateshead can be reached easily from the A1 and A19 and is effectively signposted from each of these main highways. Gateshead International Stadium is located on the main A184 road (Felling bypass) which runs through the town centre.

By Rail

Nearest station is Newcastle Central Station. The Tyne and Wear Metro System runs directly from the Station – alight at the Gateshead Stadium Station.

By Air
